The after party will be at Main Event in north Fort Worth, 2601 Presidio Vista Drive, FW, 76177. The event will start between 11-12, whenever the kids arrive from prom, and will be over at 4:30 am. The busses will arrive back at the school around 5 am. The activities include: bowling (plus tournament), arcade games, ropes course, laser tag, cash cubes, casino, pool tables (plus tournament), ping pong tables (plus tournament), flip books, and shuffle board.
